Dukungan Penuh Pemerintah dalam Penguatan Pasokan, Operasional PGN Terjaga Andal

Jakarta, 17 Agustus 2025 – PT Perusahaan Gas Negara Tbk (PGN) didukung oleh Kementerian ESDM, SKK Migas, PT Pertamina (Persero) dan pemangku kepentingan terkait lainnya secara intensif telah mengambil langkah-langkah yang dibutuhkan untuk menjaga keandalan dan stabilisasi pasokan gas bagi pelanggan di wilayah Jawa Barat dan sebagian Sumatera.
