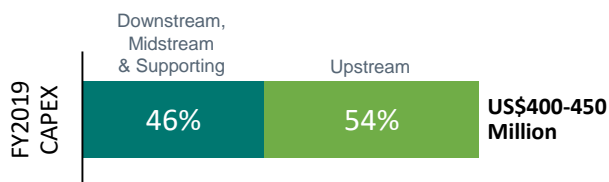
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## April 2019 Operational Highlights

PT Perusahaan Gas Negara Tbk. (IDX: PGAS) today announces key operating performance updates ended 30 April 2019 as follows:

## General Assumptions

- We expect Pertagas to incur additional supply from gas supplier in Sumatra. Accordingly on the downstream side of business, we expect increasing gas sales to customers.
- Expected volume growth for regasification due to MVPP Belawan coming online in North Sumatra

## Overview

- Higher distribution volumes in April 2019 due to improving demand from both industrial/retail and power sector.
- Higher gas delivery through Pertagas transmission pipeline in South Sumatra, East Java and Kalimantan contributes to an increased volume in our transportation business.
- Improved performance of our upstream business in April 2019 primarily triggered by higher lifting from LNG and LPG assets.
- Other contributors in April 2019 represent Pertagas business segments from Regasification, LPG Processing and Oil Transportation which successfully maintain their positive operational performance.

- The Duri-Dumai transmission line just started commercial delivery in April 2019. We expect gas delivery ramping up within second half this year
- Expected volume growth to come from Pertagas's transmission pipelines in South and North Sumatra. However, declines from Jambi Merang and Kalimantan Java pipelines could see lower transportation volumes overall.
